COMMUNITY GIFTS PROGRAM INFORMATION

MISSION:

Service League of Green Bay, Inc. is a charitable organization whose purpose is to meet physical, educational, and emotional needs of the children of Brown County by providing volunteer hours and financial support.

POLICY:

Fund raising activities are undertaken primarily to generate financial support necessary for League projects and Community Gifts. All monies raised, less administrative expenses are returned to the community in the form of service and assistance to children. Service League Community Gifts exists because we recognize that some necessary services are best provided through other organizations, and therefore give financial support to these programs.

GUIDELINES:

Gifts will be considered according to the following guidelines:

1. The program or service funded must be directed toward the physical, educational, or emotional needs of **children less than eighteen years of age living in Brown County.**
2. The program or service must be offered through a non-profit agency or service organization, or through a public agency.
3. Funds may be provided to initiate or maintain programs or services meeting a demonstrated need.
4. Agencies or organizations requesting financial assistance must be willing to complete Service League's request for financial information, to answer questions related to the program that may be asked by the Community Gifts committee, and to supply program follow-up information when requested.
5. Funds should not be allocated for purely administrative salaries.
6. Funds may be allocated if training or compensation is needed in order to provide a direct service to children that meet our mission statement criteria.
